





 - ✓ The illustrated and user-friendly style of the book will ensure the message is read and understood by everyone, even those with little knowledge of the English language.





We as a society must focus on the importance of highlighting what binds us together as British, rather than emphasising things that divide us. We all have a responsibility to help prevent radicalisation, and the community leaders play a key role in this. By working together, the community leaders will play an important role in this challenging time. In order to do this, we must work together, by supporting, educating and engaging communities, communities need to be more open and inclusive, and by addressing the causes of fear, tolerance and understanding as a key element in reducing drivers for radicalisation and extremism.

WHAT CAN WE ALL DO TO PREVENT RADICALISATION

THE FAMILY: Family support and intervention are critical elements to preventing radicalisation and extremism. It is important to remember that individuals are more likely to act out and change over time, and least likely to be interviewed.

THE COMMUNITY: Community leaders must be prepared to promote education and engagement activities to prevent radicalisation and extremism. It is important to keep your concerns with the police and other agencies confidential.

THE COMMUNITY LEADER: Community leaders must be prepared to intervene and support individuals who are at risk of radicalisation and extremism by focusing on positive alternatives.

SOCIETY AT LARGE: It is important for mainstream population to get involved in their local community and interact with people from different backgrounds, personally rather than through the media.



SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY
HOW TO BE MORE VIGILANT

WHO, WHAT, WHERE, WHEN, WHY, HOW

Those who commit terrorist acts often live amongst us without appearing suspicious while secretly planning and preparing their attack. They may be your neighbour, colleague or friend. They become vulnerable to detection if you watch for certain characteristics.



RADICALISATION Signs to look out for ...

RADICALISATION

Radicalisation is when an individual's thinking, beliefs and behaviour changes significantly, leading them to how society at large view the social and political issues. They may begin to associate with a particular group, which becomes a source of strength and support when they begin to advocate their views to achieve a political, religious or ideological goal.

VIOLENT EXTREMISM

If a person or group believes that force, threat or violence are justified to achieve ideological, political or social change, and then acts on those beliefs, this is violent extremism.



SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY
SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING

TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING DETAILS:


- PERSON:** Not like normal people, gender, age, physical description.
- ACTIVITY:** Doing exactly what they say they do, doing what they ought to be doing.
- LOCATION:** Pounds and locations, with names of roads, streets, etc.
- CLOTHING:** Consider what they are wearing, including shoes.
- TIME:** Precise date, time, and duration of activity.
- EQUIPMENT:** Consider vehicles, make, color, license plates, number, year, etc.

ANYONE WITH SEVERAL OF THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS MAY BE A SUICIDE BOMBER

- Are nervous, sweating, or trembling.
- Are wearing loose or bulky clothing.
- Are wearing many small objects to mask chemical odors.
- Do not look like they belong or what they are wearing.
- Are carrying or wearing heavy objects.
- Holding a bag or package close to his or her body.
- Are wearing dark clothing.
- Wearing one or both hands in pockets.
- Having bags or padding around the midsection.
- Appearing well-groomed but wear sloppy clothing.
- Making a pale face from being scared.
- Not responding to direct calls or greetings.
- Walking in a deliberate, stiff, or awkward manner.
- Acting in an unusually frightened manner.
- Showing an blank or focused facial expression.
- Exhibiting unusually calm and detached behavior.

SOME OF THE SHOCKING ACTS OF TERRORISM IN THE RECENT YEARS

2015	A series of coordinated terrorist attacks and suicide bombings in Paris killing 130 people and injuring over 400.
2008	Multiple attacks at the 2008 Madrid Metro, killing 190 people and injuring over 2000.
2004	A series of coordinated suicide bomb attacks in central London killing 52 people and injuring over 700.
2003	Several suicide bombings on three trains in Madrid, killing 113 people and injuring over 400.
2001	Two hijacked planes were crashed into the Twin Towers of the World Trade Center in New York City, killing 2,700 people.
2002	An Israeli bus was bombed at which a suicide bomber exploded a roadside bomb killing 32 people and injuring over 100 people.
1998	The bombing in the Islamic Republic of Iran, killing 190 people including 180 American citizens.

COUNTER-TERRORISM AND SECURITY ACT 2015

PART 3
Allowing Data Retention so relevant authorities can identify the individual or the device that was using a particular internet protocol address at any given time.

PART 4
Measures on border and transport security giving powers in respect of immigration, air and sea transport operating to the UK.

PART 5
Chapter 1 creates a duty for specified bodies to have due regard to the need to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism.

PART 6
An insurer commits an offence if they make a payment under an insurance contract for medical or property damage in response to a demand made wholly or partly for the purposes of terrorism.

PART 7
Part 7 of the Act relates to miscellaneous and general provisions. Section 47 provides for the review of certain regulations by the Secretary of State and the Home Office Commission, specifically applications for British Overseas Territories citizenship.

HOW DO PEOPLE BECOME RADICALISED?

Radicalisation can be described as a process by which people come to freely choose a dangerously and wickedly misguided path that they nonetheless perceive to be a virtuous calling.

WHAT TRIGGERS OR ACCELERATES THE RADICALISATION PROCESS

- Confrontation with family members
- Changes in living or employment situation
- Subjected to hateful attitude and actions such as hate crime
- Personal issues such as health problems, addiction, anger or social issues
- Dropping out of school, college or university
- Negative changes to personal relationships, friends etc.
- Discrimination or social unfairness
- Witnessing of events that harms family, community or society
